RULE CHANGE – REQUEST FOR SUBMISSIONS UNDER RULE 400(1)(a)

C13/04RS – Deemed Injection Quantities

Introduction

The REMCo CEO, under the delegation of the REMCo Board, endorsed the recommended Rule Change C13/04RS – Deemed Injection Quantities on 20 August 2004. REMCo is seeking submissions on this endorsed rule change as required under Rule 400(1)(a) of the Retail Market Rules (**RMR**).

How to make a Submission on the Endorsed Rule Change

As provided under Rule 400(2), each participant, pipeline operator, prescribed person and interested person may lodge a submission on the endorsed rule change.

Please note that if no submission is received from a participant, pipeline operator, shipper, swing service provider or other interested persons by the closing date, REMCo will take this as being agreement to the endorsed rule change.

Background Information

Summary of Endorsed Rule Change

Rule 246 of the RMR requires REMCo to publish a shippers Deemed Injection Amounts to the shipper, swing service provider and the pipeline operator, where these amounts are aggregated for each sub-network.



The endorsed change requests for the Deemed Injection Amounts to be allocated by user. This will require an amendment to Rule 246 of the RMR, and an amendment to sections 10.9.10.2 and 10.9.10.4 of the Interface Control Document (“ICD”).

Endorsed Rule Change

Amend Rule 246(1)(b) as follows:

“(b) then summing all amounts allocated by user to the shipper or swing service provider (as applicable) under rule 246(1)(a).”

Amend the ICD as follows:

The following changes to the ICD will be required if Rule 246(1)(b) is amended as proposed:

Deemed Injections (DI)

Data flow Definition

The data estimation entity to notify shippers and swing service providers of their deemed injections

Physical Mapping

The data for this flow must be provided in an automated electronic file.
